2. Two strange mandates and their power vv 9-33
A. God's work in answering this prayer was happening in Cornelius AND far away from Cornelius.B. What you may consider strange may be the work of God in you for the benefit of someone else.
3. A simple message and the Holy Spirit's presence vv 34-48
A. Peter and those with him would witness for themselves that the Gospel both Jew and Gentile.
B. Though God's timing and tools may be mysterious, His working is unmistakable.
