Three traits of a thriving marriage:
1 (vv 1-14)
A. Purity in marriage for wisdom and discretion. Why?
B. How does a couple enjoy purity in marriage? Solomon helps us in vv 7-14.
1. Keep your attentive to wisdom (God's Word), not the titillating
suggestions of the world.
2. Get from the temptation. "Keep your way far from her".
3 about the end. How do you do that? A couple of ways: read the scripture
and it will tell you the end of sin and there are probably examples around you.
2 (vv 15-19)
A. Intimacy is a of time and focus and hard work on the marriage.
"When a husband and wife are faithful to the Lord and to each other, and when they obey Scriptures
like 1 Corinthians 7:1–5 and Ephesians 5:22–33, neither of them will look for satisfaction anywhere
else. If they love each other and seek to please each other and the Lord, their relationship will be one
of deepening joy and satisfaction; they won't look around for "the greener grass."

Bin marriage is a vicious and continuous fight against selfishness, worldliness,
and the devil. Someone defined intimacy as "into me you see."
How to grow in intimacy:
1. What did you do when you were dating that caught their eye?
2. Pray together.
3. LISTEN! Give her/him your undivided attention.
4. Ask for suggestions.
5. Be generous in giving affection.
6. Are you stuck? Get help.
3 (vv 20-23)
A. Thinking about consequences in the will greatly affect the
consequences in the future.
The Lord considers every single path we take.
B. Transparency before the Lord builds in Him. Transparency before your spouse
builds trust with her (him).
How to be transparent:
1 Psalm 139:23-24: "Search me, O God, and know my heart. Try me and
know my anxious ways"
2. Tell your spouse she/he has to every device and account you have.
What now?
1. Be with the Spirit.
