- - A. Whatever had occupied Joshua's thinking came to a halt as he encountered the Lord.
 - B. Some things we MUST stop if we are to listen:
 - 1. Stop talking.
- 3. Stop making excuses.
- Stop taking.
 Stop making excuses.
 Stop looking for an emotion/feeling.
- - A. Joshua would quickly realize that some things must be "set" in order to listen.

The Lord didn't come to take sides: He came to take over!

- B. Some things must be set if we are to listen:
 - 1. Set aside time.
 - 2. Set aside your agenda (expectations).

If the Lord can only do according to our agenda, we have inflated egos and a very pitiful idea of just how great God really is.

- 3. Set your mind on things above (*Colossians 3:2*).
- 4. Set what you think you are hearing alongside God's Word.
- - A. Joshua's start with the Lord in this encounter was crucial and right.
 - B. Some things must start to show that we are listening:
 - 1. Start now.
 - 2. Start obeying in the small things.
 - 3. Start taking in God's Word more than any other source.
 - 4. Start taking God at His Word. You can trust Him.
