

Parents, you are still the greatest influence on your children. You influence them even when you feel like you may have blown it. 1. Say "I'm sorry" often and genuinely. 2. Live for Christ inside the walls of your home. 3. Do not hide your struggles from your children, but let them see that you are seeking the Lord and trusting him even, and especially, in the waiting. 4. More than just taking your kids to church, let them see you genuinely worshiping and growing in your walk with Christ in that setting. 5. More than just challenging your kids to excel in a sport or activity, challenge them to grow in their walk with Jesus most 6. Consider this question, "If Paul came to your house tomorrow, would your son or daughter be considered to go on mission with him?" 7.
