Sermon Series: One Step Further: Journey to the Cross Dr. Brian Stowe, Senior Pastor Sermon Title: Jesus: Our Model (Luke 4:1-14) March 6, 2022

Hebrews 4:14-16

To overcome temptation (today, and to be repeated tomorrow):

1. Be _____ with the Spirit (v 1)

A. As Jesus obeyed the Father through His baptism, the Holy Spirit marked Him and filled Him. B. Being filled with the Holy Spirit will not happen apart from being obedient to the Lord.

Obeying the Father pleases Him.

2. Be _____ by the Spirit (vv 1-2)

A. Being led by the Spirit does not mean we are kept away from temptation.

"Facing the devil is certainly the time to fast, to face God as intensely

as possible at the same time the devil faces you." - T.C. Butler

- *B. Facing, and overcoming, temptation are best accomplished under the leading of the Holy Spirit.*
 - 1. Our walk with the Lord leads us into spiritual battle in God's time and God's way.
 - 2. Being led by the Spirit will put us in places where we can know the Lord better.
 - 3. Being led by the Spirit will physically, mentally, and emotionally challenge you.

3. _____ the Sword of the Spirit - the Word of God (vv 3-12)

A. As the devil tempted Jesus, Jesus responded with the Word of God each time.

B. The Word of God (the Sword of the Spirit) will keep you from falling to the enemy's snares.

4. _____ forward in the power of the Spirit (vv 13-14)

A. The enemy may leave, but he'll be back.

B. What we may think drains us or limits us are actually the tools that help us live in the power of the Spirit.
